CROCHET 1 Beginning Crochet

BASIC KNITTING: The Complete Course

Tuition: \$190 / 6 week session

Prerequisite: Knitting 1 or some familiarity with knitting

Continue your knitting journey beyond the knit and purl in this six-week complete knitting course. You will learn everything you need to get started on wonderful knitted projects. We will begin with a review of the basics and progress to gauge, fixing mistakes increases and decreases, simple cables, lace and finishing!

SIX WEEK SESSION Wednesday Feb 29 – April 4 6:00 – 8:00 pm

INTERMEDIATE KNITTING: Complete Course

Tuition: \$190 / 6 week session

Materials: Purchased at Lion Brand Yarn Studio: 10% off all supplies.

Prerequisite: Must know how to knit, purl, cast on, bind off, and work simple increases and decreases. Recognize the knit and purl stitch and be able to work them in a pattern without supervision.

In this perfect follow up to Knitting 2 or Basic Knitting the Complete Course, we will knit a child sized sweater to learn basic garment shaping, seaming, picking up stitches for a button band and three needle bind off. On alternate weeks we will learn how to use double pointed needles to knit in the round, stranded color work, short rows, more options for casting on and binding off and how to recognize and repair mistakes.

Dora Ohrenstein: Great Fabric with Any Yarn - TAKE ONE CLASS OR BOTH!

Tuition: \$70/ 3 hour session (includes \$10 of yarn) or \$100 for both classes (includes \$10 of yarn)

Prerequisite: Ability to read crochet instructions, both written out and stitch diagrams.

Think of this class as a totally fun SWATCH PARTY that will teach you tons about how to get just the type of fabric you need. We will work with a variety of yarns, weights and fibers. Once you understand how to select the hook size and stitch pattern that brings out the very best in each yarn, you can make anything from feathery light shawls, to beautifully draped sweaters, sturdy outerwear and functional bags or belts. Take one part or both!

Pt 1: Drape of Fabric: In this section of the class, we will focus on how to make crochet fabric that drapes well, the key factor in creating good-looking garments, shawls, scarves and slouchy hats.

Pt 2 Quality of Fabric: This section will be devoted to the quality of fabric that is the opposite of drape: structure. If you want to make a jacket that really keeps out the cold, a truly functional belt, or a bag that holds its shape, this class will arm you with the necessary knowledge.

Margaret Radcliffe: Helix Knitting

Tuition: \$65/ 3 hour session

Prerequisite: Students must be comfortable working small tubes in the round using at least ONE of the following methods: double-pointed needles, two circular needles, or magic loop.

Knit circular stripes with absolutely no jogs. No one will ever find your beginning and end of round. Use as few as two colors or as many as you like. This technique produces perfect interlocking spirals of each color. Class will cover casting on, shaping, and working on circular needles, magic loop, two circulars and double pointed needles.

Margaret Radcliffe: Seaming Without Sewing

Tuition: \$65/ 3 hour session

Prerequisite: Must know cast on and bind off, working knits and purls.

Love to knit but hate to seam? Knit beautiful garments, but hate the way they look when they're finished? Finishing can make the difference between "professionally hand crafted" and "home made." If you have sweaters in pieces just waiting to be finished because you find sewing annoying, have trouble seeing to sew, difficulty holding a sewing needle, or just plain hate to sew, this class is for you. Learn to use crochet, binding off, picking up, and knitting on make perfect seams, plus perfect afterthought pockets.

Adrienne Sloane: KNITTING WITH WIRE (Knitting On the Rocks!)

Tuition: \$95/ 6 hour session

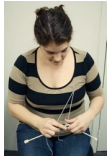
Materials: \$15 materials fee for wire

Expand your knit horizons and get wired! An introduction to small scale work, this workshop presents alternative approaches to successful jewelry knitting with wire. Learn new ways to create knit stitches while exploring tubular structures, including how to encapsulate objects within knitting. Using basic stitches and copper wire in a beautiful range of colors, students will have the opportunity to design and execute unique pieces while we also cover resources, materials and further design ideas. Previous wire or jewelry experience not required but basic knit skills necessary. For knit fanatics who want to knit everything they see. Bring your own rocks.

KNITTING Workshops February - March 2012



Portuguese Knitting

Tuition: \$60 / 3 hour session

Materials: Knitting pin included. Additional materials must be purchased at Lion Brand Yarn Studio. 10% off all class supplies.

Prerequisite: Must know how to knit, purl, cast on, bind off & simple increases & decreases and be able to work them without supervision.

There are many different ways to make the same stitch! In addition to English (or throwing) and Continental (or picking) styles, there is a style of knitting which involves holding the yarn around the neck or around a hook pinned near the shoulder. This style, popular in Turkey, Egypt and Peru, was popularized and named Portuguese knitting by Andrea Wong. This is a wonderful technique to add to your knitting bag of tricks. Perfect for folks who suffer from carpal tunnel or arthritis, it is also one of the fastest and most efficient ways to knit (also great for lefties!). Another advantage of Portuguese Knitting is a more even purl stitch and a simple way to do Fair Isle inside out! (T)

Intro to Brioche Knitting: Make a Baby Sweater (NEW)

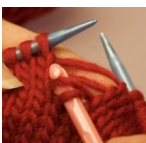

Prerequisite: Must know how to knit, purl, cast on, bind off & simple increases & decreases and be able to work them without supervision.

The Brioche Stitch, or “patentsteek” in Dutch where the stitch comes from, is a special stitch pattern that has a very distinct texture. An alternate form of the basic stitch is called Fisherman’s Rib. In this introduction class, we will cover how to execute the basics in the form of a baby sweater. Learn about “barks” and “burps”, increasing and decreasing in Brioche, and talk about how Brioche fabric differs from standard knitted fabric in regards to gauge and pattern reading. (P, I, S)

Knitting Surgeon Level 1: Mistakes and How to Fix Them

Prerequisite: Must know how to knit, purl, cast on, bind off. Recognize the knit and purl stitch and be able to work them in a pattern without supervision.

Get out of any knitting jam. Learn how to “read your knitting” and recognize common mistakes. Learn how to “tink” (unknit), pick up a dropped stitch in stockinette, garter, fix a mistake in rib or any stitch pattern. We will also learn how to insert and rip down to a safety line, how to recognize and fix reversed stitch mounts and MORE. Take heart, help is here. (B, F, T)

My First Sweater - Knitting From the Top Down

Tuition: \$75 / 3 week session (3 – 2 hr classes)

Knitting from the top down means virtually no seaming! In this class you will learn the basic principles of the top down raglan, and then apply them to make this flattering raglan, all-in-one piece cardigan. Knit in chunky weight yarn, this is a fast knit and ideal for your first sweater! (G, P)

Buttonholes and Button Bands (NEW)

There's more than one way to make a hole! Explore the many ways to make buttonholes and button bands. In this class we will learn YO, one row, two row buttonholes, as well as horizontal and vertical buttonholes. We will go over the secrets to picking up stitches for the perfect button band as well as knitted on button bands. Discover other options such as button loops and reinforced buttonholes, as well as tricks to keeping your buttons from pulling at your fabric and how to evenly space your buttonholes. (T, G)

This technique is perfect for projects that involve a lot of turning, like Entrelac, Short Rows & Bobbles. It's also great for color work and charts. Find a new way to look at your knitting! (T)

No Pattern Sock

In class we will make a mini-sock, and you will leave with all the information you need to custom fit a sock to anyone's foot. (P, T)

In this course you will learn about the various types of edgings, how to attach, pick up stitches (vertical or horizontal) and how to pick the right edging for your projects. In this workshop you will learn the i-cord bind off, lace, zig zag, and MORE! Let us push your knitting over the edge! (S)

Intro to Hand Felting

In this class we will hand felt a clutch. Learn the basics of felting in this class where we'll make a small clutch and felt it by hand to feel the fibers change. Experience in your hands what happens when you felt pieces in the washing machine and observe the stages of felting. We will discuss how to swatch for felted projects and measure swatches before and after felting. (B, I, P, T)

Knitting Surgeon Level 2: Alterations and Major Fixes

Tuition: \$55 / 3 hour session

Materials: Must be purchased at Lion Brand Yarn Studio. 10% off all class supplies.

Prerequisite: Knitting Surgeon Level 1 or being comfortable with picking up dropped stitches, properly unknitting WITHOUT reversing stitch mounts. Must know how to knit, purl, cast on, bind off, know K2tog, YO, SSK, M1, SK2P, S2KP, KFB and follow them in a pattern without supervision.

Delve beyond picking up a dropped stitch into more major fixes. Learn how to "tink" or un-knit increases and decreases w/o losing a stitch. Reverse a cable or add a missing cable many rows down. Fix common mistakes in lace such as a missing YO or a K2tog three rows down. Even learn how to shorten or lengthen your knitted piece. You have the power to fix without frogging! (T)

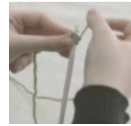

Finishing for Knitters

Finishing techniques help you take your pieces from homemade-looking to professionally polished. In this workshop you will learn all the basic finishing techniques, working on your swatches. We will go through mattress stitch on garter stitch, stockinette side-to-side and end-to-end, three needle bind-off, kitchener stitch and the art of weaving in ends A must for every knitter. (F, G)

Design Your Own Dish Towels (NEW)

Triangular Lace Shawl

Learn to knit a simple lace triangular shawl. In this class we will make the Spice Route Shawl pattern. Knit from the center back towards the corners, the shawl grows with every row! We will learn about triangular shawl structure and introductory lace techniques, and finish with a delicate crochet edging. We will discuss blocking techniques for different fibers, and the importance of blocking lace. (P)

Intro to Entrelac

Prerequisite: Must know how to knit, purl, cast on, bind off & simple increases & decreases and be able to work them without supervision.

Entrelac is an ingenious knitting technique that creates the illusion of a basket woven fabric by working rows of textured diamond patterns. If you know simple increases and decreases and how to knit and purl, you can master this impressive looking technique. (C, I, S)

Combination Knitting: Take Control of Your Stitches

Tuition: \$55/ 3 hour session

Prerequisite: Must know how to knit, purl, cast on, bind off. Recognize the knit and purl stitch and be able to work them in a pattern without supervision.

Have you been told you knit “differently”? Do you sometimes twist your stitches and don’t know why? You might be a Combination Knitter. Combination Knitting (or Eastern Uncrossed Knitting), knits through the back loop, and purls by scooping the yarn under the needle. Learn the adjustments you can make to follow Western patterns, like how to knit in the round and understand left and right slanting increases. If you are a Western knitter, come learn a different knitting style. If you’ve are a continental knitter that have always had trouble mastering the purl, this might be the class for you! (F, T)

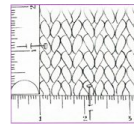


Knitting Technique

You will learn how to swatch flat for an in- the-round pattern, and how to adjust a pattern size by switching yarn. (B, F, G)

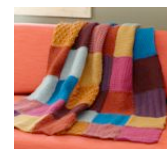
